Ascorbic acid is an organic compound with formula $C_6H_8O_6$, originally called hexuronic acid. It is a white solid, but impure samples can appear yellowish. It dissolves well in water to give mildly acidic solutions. It is a mild reducing agent. Ascorbic acid exists as two enantiomers (mirror-image isomers), commonly denoted "L" (for "levo") and "D" (for "dextro").
