Water has a very high specific heat capacity of $4.1814 \text{ J}/(\text{g}\cdot\text{K})$ at 25°C – the second highest among all the heteroatomic species (after ammonia), as well as a high heat of vaporization (40.65 kJ/mol or 2257 kJ/kg at the normal boiling point), both of which are a result of the extensive hydrogen bonding between its molecules.
